The sporting and solidarity challenge
From June 1 to 28, 2026



Solidarity objective

Raise funds to finance the solidarity actions organized by the Cancer@Work association: free workshops to support the return to work of people affected by cancer or a chronic illness.

Collective challenge

Engage your employees in a dynamic and unifying team sporting challenge.

Sports activity

Promote physical activity: running, walking or cycling.
Whether sedentary or athletic, the challenge is suitable for all levels.

NEW

10 additional activities have been added to enrich the Challenge and allow participants to earn bonus points.

E.g.: swimming, treadmill running, indoor cycling, football, yoga...

The concept

Participants create their profile and join their team on the SquadEasy app from May 18.

The challenge starts on June 1st.

For 4 weeks, each effort is rewarded: practicing a physical activity, completing a mission, answering a quiz.

Points are counted via the SquadEasy app, which can be synchronized with Strava, Garmin and Fitbit.

Created in 2012, the Cancer@Work association is the first business association dedicated to the subject of cancer, chronic illnesses and work.
